### IVANA DAMJANOV

#### Biography



Ivana Damjanov was born on the 22nd of April 1999 in Zrenjanin, Serbia. Although just 18 she is already a student of II year at The Academy of Music in Novi Sad (two years ahead of her generation) in the class of Professor Milan Miladinovic. She is one of the best and most promising Serbian pianists of younger generation.

She graduated piano at the music high school “Josif Marinkovic” in Zrenjanin and she is currently Ivana started playing in her fourth year of life with the help of professor Haupt Klara, and in her sixth year she enrolled in elementary music school in the class of professor Dijana Bugarski Miskeljcin. From that moment on, she started competing in National and International competitions.

Her first big award was in 2006 in Zagreb, where she won first prize. After that she has won over 40 first prizes. Besides piano, Ivana has awards from national and international competitions in solfeggio, chamber music and theory of music. She won The Young Talents awards, granted by the city of Zrenjanin and Novi Sad several times.

She has held solo recitals and chamber music concerts, and played with orchestra in most important cultural centers and concert venues in Novi Sad, Zrenjanin, Belgrade, Romania, Budapest(Hungary), Germany, Italy, Paris(France), Vienna(Austria), Malta etc. She was participant in many humanitarian concerts as well.
